Simple things you can do to lower your energy bill



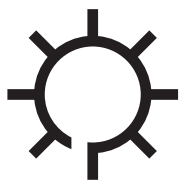
Manage your thermostat

Set your thermostat to the highest comfortable temperature. The smaller the difference between the inside and outside temperatures, the lower your bill will be.



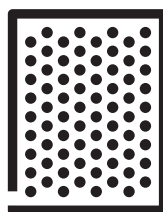
Keep the cool in

Seal cracks and holes around doors, windows and ductwork. Weather stripping and caulking will help keep the cold air in.



Keep the sun out

Close blinds, shades and curtains to keep the sun out. Also, close air conditioning vents in rooms that are not in use.



Clean and replace air filters

Air filters on some air conditioning units require monthly cleaning or replacing.



Use fans to cool off

Ceiling fans, box fans and oscillating fans use very little electricity to circulate air.



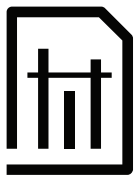
